

Dear RHS Students and Parents/Guardians,

Welcome to the 2019-2020 school year! This packet contains important information about returning to school. **For Freshmen**, school starts on Thursday, 15 August 2019 at 7:45am; all other students start school on Friday, 16 August 2019 at 7:45am. The bell schedules for the first two days of school are on page 11 of this packet. However, **before school starts students must participate in Rampart's Check-In Day on Tuesday, 6 August 2019.**

All grade levels participate in Check-In Day, but **at different times**; see page 2 for the schedule. Please plan to check-in at your assigned time; students may not check-in early. Students are expected to print their schedule from Infinite Campus any time after 5:00 pm on 5 August and bring it with them to check-in. There is no required school supply list at the high school level.

Please review all items in this packet, especially the provided check-in lists. Parents, please review the District's required back-to-school documentation – health statement, emergency contacts, publishing consent, handbook, etc. – using Infinite Campus and the Extended Parent Portal. Overdue fees and optional items (e.g. activity passes and yearbooks) may be paid online using PayForIt.net prior to check-in, or may be paid at the Fees table on Check-In Day. Please be aware that separate checks are required for photo packages (see page 2) and the Senior Walk (seniors only).

Make-up Check-In Day is Tuesday, 27 August, from 7:45am – 11:00am for all grades. This day is for students unable to make the original check-in day or have not cleared outstanding fees and/or fines from previous years. Student IDs are issued at Check-In Day and Make-up Check-In Day; otherwise, students can get IDs in room 218 after September 2019.

**\*\*If your student intends to drive to and park on campus, they MUST purchase and pick up a 2019-2020 parking permit sticker. Please note – students **must clear** outstanding fees/obligations in order to purchase a parking permit! After 30 August 2019 parking permit stickers are required to park on campus and students are subject to ticketing. See page 8.\*\***

Freshmen: On your first school day, volunteer Rampart students will help you find classes and provide activities to help you get acquainted with the high school, and the school provides a picnic-style lunch. If you want a locker/specific locker partner, fill out the [Locker Request Form](#); see page 8. Your freshman year provides the foundation for study habits, attendance, class behavior, and other parts of high school life; we encourage you to take advantage of the many student activities, clubs, sports, and music here at Rampart!

Sophomores: Your second year of high school can mean more responsibility, more advanced classes, and really starting to get an idea of what you might want to become in your life. You will have the opportunity to take the PSAT 10, a valuable tool for estimating the range you may score on the SAT test, and the only test the National Merit Scholarship Committee uses to see who qualifies for their national scholarship competition.

Juniors: Your junior year of high school is very important academically – remember, the first thing colleges will see on your transcript is your junior year record. On the flip side, involvement in school and/or community activities is also important. Time management is the skill you'll need to master! During this year you will have the opportunity to take the PSAT/NMSQT, SAT, and the ACT.

Seniors: You get to take part in many Rampart traditions this year, from the Senior Walk in September to the Senior Luncheon in April. Meanwhile, Rampart staff completes a course credit check to ensure your enrollment in classes that comply with graduation requirements; we will notify you if changes to your schedule are necessary. Time flies – start thinking about what you want to be doing this time next year!

We hope you have enjoyed your summer. We look forward to seeing you at Check-In Day on 6 August and then on your first day of school!

## CHANGES OF NOTE TO RHS CHECK-IN DAY

- Schedule changes will **NOT** be handled at Check-In. Computers will be available in the LMC for students to submit schedule change requests; see page 5 for more details.
- Parents/students cannot purchase parking permits online in order to insure outstanding fees are cleared.
- Parking stickers will **NOT** be issued at Check-In. Paper Permit Application forms will be available, and parking permits can be paid for at the Fees table. Parking permit stickers – ***required for parking on campus*** – can be picked up in room 218 starting 9 August; see page 8 for more details.
- **ALL** lockers have been re-assigned; the locker you had last year is no longer your locker. If a student would like a locker assignment, student must request one using the Rampart [Locker Request form](#) available on the RHS website; see page 8 for more details.
- Laptops will be available for parents to update their contact information in IC; it is imperative that District and school staff have a current email address and/or phone number, and home address, in order to notify parents of important student information. **Staff cannot make contact changes!**

Freshmen who have prescription glasses/contacts must bring them to the screening.  
Freshmen who miss this screening will be pulled from classes for screening on 20 August.

## MANDATORY -- ALL RHS STUDENTS must have a 2019-2020 student ID!!

**A new student ID is necessary to pick up textbooks from the Library.**

**Student IDs are issued at Check-In Day and at make-up check-in on Tuesday, 27 August; staff cannot create IDs between 6 and 27 August.**

All 9<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> grade students will receive a photograph order envelope in the mail from our school photographer, Creative Imaging, prior to Check-In Day. The envelope contains information on how to order school portraits and a **Picture Pass**. *Bring the Picture Pass with you to Check-In Day whether or not you order portraits as it expedites picture processing.* If you order portraits using the envelope, or at Check-In Day, **make your check payable to Creative Imaging, not the school.** You can also order portraits on line at [www.cidmphoto.com](http://www.cidmphoto.com) using access code RHS19. If you want an **RHS Student Activity Pass**, you **must purchase it BEFORE your student ID photo is taken**, either using PayForIt.net or at the Fees table during check-in.

Student **MUST** provide Activity Pass proof of purchase to the photographer.

### ADDRESS CHANGE

- Parents **must** keep their student's physical home address current.
- Parents **cannot** make a change of address using Extended Parent Portal, nor write it in on a form.
- Change of Address forms are available on-line or at the EAC **and require proof of address such as:**
  - warranty deed
  - bill of sale
  - closing settlement statement
  - rental agreement
  - quarters lease
  - El Paso county property tax notice
- Change of Address forms **must be turned in** to the EAC at 1110 Chapel Hills Drive.
- RHS staff cannot make these changes for you in IC.
- Laptops will be available to parents at Check-In Day to update information in IC.

## STUDENT SCHEDULE CHANGES

- Counselors will meet with students **by pre-arranged appointment only** on Check-In Day.
- Schedule Change Requests are to be submitted via **email** to your assigned counselor. Please only email **once**, and allow time for change and response. Include the class, reason, and your first and second options. Remember, only VALID requests will be honored!
- Schedule changes are made **ONLY** for the following reasons:
  1. To fill an open period in your schedule.
  2. To change a class if you do not meet the prerequisites/requirements for a class you have on your schedule.
  3. To retake a class that you failed.
  4. To fill an A or B section of the same course.
- Counselors **will not** honor specific teacher requests, lunch request, or classes with friends.
- Schedule change requests will be accepted until Thursday, 15 August 2019.

### ATHLETICS

**NEW:** CHSAA and District 20 REQUIRE both athlete and parent/guardian set up an account on ArbiterAthlete; this **MUST** be done for an athlete to be added to the sport roster. The tutorial is available at [www.rampart.asd20.org](http://www.rampart.asd20.org) under the athletics tab. Online registration and athletic fee payment will be available on ArbiterAthlete and PayForIt on Monday, 1July. Online registrations for fall season must be completed by 8 August at midnight. *AFTER THIS DATE/TIME IT IS LATE AND YOU MUST COMPLETE THE ONLINE REGISTRATION PROCESS **AND** COME TO THE ATHLETIC OFFICE BEGINNING AT 8:00AM ON 12 AUGUST TO GET A LATE PASS.* Athletes **CANNOT** begin practice until the online registration process is complete. Athletes **MUST** have a current sports physical good through the entire season, signed by a physician, and uploaded on ArbiterAthlete. If it expires at any time during the season you cannot tryout or practice – **NO EXCEPTIONS!** The Athletic Office is closed on Friday, 9 August.

### TEXTBOOKS

- Outstanding textbooks/novels **MUST** be returned to the LMC, and student **MUST** present payment receipt for library fees, prior to a student receiving current year textbooks.
- Students **MUST** present a 2019-2020 student ID in order to receive current year textbooks.
- Students **MUST** present a printed student schedule. Students who have not printed their class schedule at home can come to the LMC – with a current year student ID – to print their schedule. This schedule will include student locker information.
- Students can pay library fines at the Fees table during Check-In Day; bring payment receipt to library.

### STUDENT HANDBOOK

Rampart administration **requires** that parents and students read the Rampart High School Student Handbook. It contains valuable information for parents and students alike, and some policies have changed from previous years. Parents can use the Extended Parent Portal in IC to electronically sign and date the handbook. Parents must check the box indicating that they have read and agree to the handbook in order to gain access to their portal account info each year. The Student Handbook is available on line on the RHS web site; paper copies are also available in room 218 and should be available at check-in.

## PARKING

- Parking permit stickers **WILL NOT BE ISSUED** on Check-In Day.
- Parking permits cannot be purchased until student's overdue RHS fees are cleared.
- A student **DOES NOT** have a parking permit unless the parking permit sticker is visible in their vehicle.
  1. Parent/Student **MUST** complete a new paper or on-line 2019-2020 Parking Application Form for vehicle registration (paper form available at Check-In; turn it in to room 218).
  2. Parent/Student **MUST** purchase the parking permit at the Fees table, through Bookkeeping or in room 218 once outstanding fees are cleared.
  3. Parent/Student **MUST** pick up a parking permit sticker in room 218.
- Parent/Student **should** complete vehicle information through the Extended Parent Portal.
- Parent/Student **should** read the Parking section of the Student Handbook for rules, violations, and fines.
- Parking permits will be required to park at RHS after 30 August 2019; fines will be enforced thereafter.
- Parking permit stickers from previous school years are **not valid** and will be fined as such.

## LOCKERS

- **RAMPART ASSIGNS LOCKERS ONLY UPON REQUEST.**
- Student locker assignments from previous school years are not valid.
- RHS collects student requests for locker assignments or a locker partner electronically *starting 10 June 2019*. Please use the [Locker Request Form](#) available on the RHS website, and follow the instructions to make your request.
- Students must complete the locker request form *by 1 August 2019*. If a student misses that date, students can submit a paper locker request at Check-In Day or in room 218 starting 9 August 2019.
- Parent/Student **should** read the rules concerning lockers in the RHS Student Handbook.
- Students will **NOT** get a locker assignment during Check-In Day, but can receive confirmation of their locker assignment if the request was submitted prior to 1 August.

# FROM COUNSELING

**Naviance Family Connection** is a comprehensive website that you and your student can use to help in **making plans about courses, colleges, and careers**. Family connection is linked with Naviance Succeed, a service that we use in our office to track and analyze data about college and career plans, so it provides up-to-date information that is specific to our school.

Family connection will allow you and your student to:

- **Get involved in the planning and advising process**
  - Build a resume
  - Complete online surveys
  - Manage timelines and deadlines for making decisions about colleges and careers
- **Research college** – compare GPA, standardized test scores, and other statistics to actual historical data from our school for students who have applied and been admitted in the past.
- **Research Careers** – Research hundreds of careers and career clusters, and take career assessments like the Do What You Are test.
- **Create plans for the future** – Build course plans, create goals and to-do's, and complete tasks assigned to you by the school to better prepare yourself for your future college and career goals.
- **Request Transcripts** – All transcripts and recommendations must be requested and processed through Naviance.

Family Connection also lets us share information with you and your student about upcoming meetings and events, local scholarship opportunities, and other resources for college and career information. To visit our school's Naviance Family connection site, use your browser to connect to the RHS website under the logins tab. The username is the student's ID number. The password is the student's first name initial, last name initial and 6-digit birthdate. Please note that this password will never change even if your student changes their Infinite Campus password. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the counseling office.

# HEALTH INFORMATION

## HEARING / VISION SCREENING FOR FRESHMEN

According to state guidelines, all incoming freshmen must participate in yearly vision and hearing screening. For the 2019-2020 school year, all freshmen will be screened in rooms 113 & 115 on Tuesday, 6 August 2019, from 7:30am - 9:30am. Please encourage your student to wear eye glasses/contacts if prescribed.

## HEALTH CARE PLANS

To protect the health and safety of your student at school, it is the responsibility of the student's parent/guardian to notify the school nurse about acute and/or chronic health conditions. Please review your student's listed health conditions in Infinite Campus/Parent Portal to ensure they are current, and contact the school nurse if you need to update your student's health information in IC. Health care forms related to Asthma/Diabetes/Severe Allergy/Seizures are available on the ASD20 website under "health services". It is imperative a health care plan (updated annually for current school year) is on file in the health office for students with asthma, life threatening allergies, seizures, diabetes, etc. You can give health plans to the school nurse during Check-In Day.

## IMMUNIZATIONS

Please note that in addition to the vaccines required by the state of Colorado Board of Health for school entry, there are vaccines recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). Please discuss your child's vaccination needs with your child's doctor or local public health agency. (To find your local public health department's contact information call the Family Health Line at 1-303-692-2229 or 1-800-688-7777). Parents, please review the parent portal on Infinite Campus to see if your student's immunization record complies with the 2019-2020 immunization requirements. **Under Colorado law (C.R.S. §254- 902), the penalty for failing to comply with the vaccination requirements or take an exemption will result in suspension.**

Schools work hard to ensure compliance with the immunization laws. We greatly appreciate your help in providing updated immunization records at initial school registration and when your child receives additional vaccine(s). If you have updated your student's immunization record since the previous school year, please bring it to Check-In Day on 6 August 2019 or by the first day of school to room 103. You can contact the nurse at 234-2168.

## MEDICATIONS

In high school, students who are mature and capable of taking their own over-the-counter or prescription medication (excluding controlled drugs) may self-carry their medication as instructed by their physician and/or parent, provided the medication is in the original drug container. For controlled medications, parents and student must follow Academy School District 20 and State Medication Administration guidelines. Parents/guardians must physically bring all controlled medications to and from the school health office; school personnel administer controlled medications to students. Parents/guardians must complete a District Medication Consent Form signed by both parent/guardian and the medical provider with prescriptive authority. The prescription medication must come in the original pharmacy container. Controlled medications are, but not limited to, stimulants, prescribed pain medications, antidepressants, anticonvulsants, and antipsychotics.

## ALTERNATING BLOCK SCHEDULE

District 20 high schools use an alternating block schedule of classes, in which students can take up to eight 90-minute classes that meet every other day during the semester. Here at Rampart these are called blue and gold days. Exceptions to this are green day schedules used after 2-hour delays or snow days, days with special events or assemblies, and the Freshmen first day of school and all students first day of school, which are listed below.

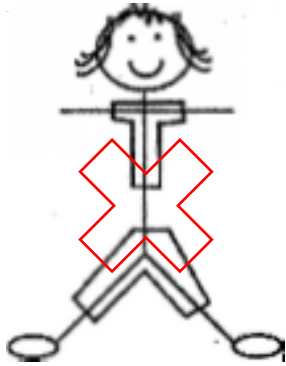

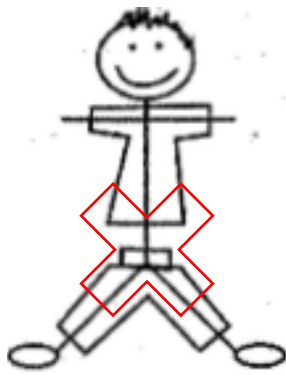

Your shirt should come to the top of your pants or skirt and not ride up when you move.



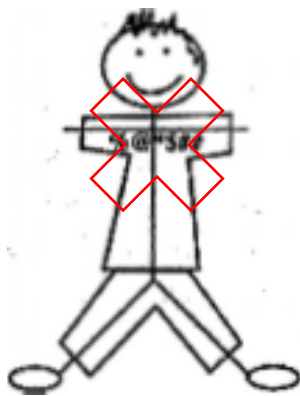
Keep your pants pulled up!
