Graduation Requirements

- ▶ 50 TOTAL CREDITS ARE REQUIRED
 - ▶ If a student takes full credit classes, they could earn 16 credits per year.
 - ▶ That is potentially 64 credits at graduation.
- ▶ **New graduation requirements**
 - ▶ In addition to current credit requirements, students will have to show proficiency in both **MATH** and **ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS**.

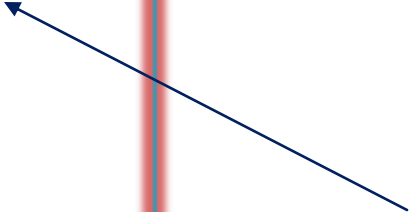

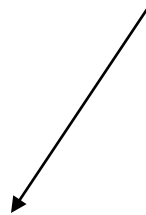

What is MYP?

- ▶ MYP stands for Middle Years Programme
- ▶ Involves grades 6-10 of the International Baccalaureate Programme
- ▶ Inclusive of ALL learners
- ▶ MYP encourages international-mindedness and a positive attitude to learning, and emphasizes the development of the whole student—physically, intellectually, emotionally, and ethically.

- ▶ Students have the opportunity to participate in the PERSONAL PROJECT and engage in ACTION & SERVICE as part of the MYP.
