

To the **SOPHOMORE** Class of 2020 and their Parents / Guardians,

We hope you are thoroughly enjoying your summer with family and friends. We are really excited to have you back for a great year!

Sophomore check-in day will be Monday, 7 August from 1:30pm to 3:30pm. Students are expected to print their schedule from Infinite Campus any time after 5:00 pm 5 August and bring it to sophomore check-in. You will be photographed for the yearbook, issued your student ID card, and will check out your textbooks. If you do not already have but want a locker, you will be assigned one; if you have a locker partner in mind please fill out the Locker Assignment form on our website prior to check-in and we will assign you both a shared locker. If you no longer need a locker, please inform staff at check-in so the locker can be re-assigned.

Please review the check-in list carefully and complete all of the items necessary for 10th grade students. Please pay all applicable registration fees online through PayForIt.net. You can pay with a credit card or an electronic check. If you choose not to use this convenient method of payment, you will need to be prepared to pay all registration fees at check-in, as well as additional fees for a yearbook (optional) and/or school pictures. Separate payment is required for school pictures (see their website cidmphoto.com). If you are unable to attend sophomore check-in day, there will be a makeup check-in day on Monday, 28 August.

Sophomore first day of school is Tuesday, 15 August, from 7:45 am to 2:45 pm. Students will follow a green day schedule – 8 periods plus an assembly. Your schedule will be available on Infinite Campus, 5 August after 5:00 pm. Please print a copy of your schedule and bring it with you on the first day of school! Please bring something to write with on the first day of school.

Your sophomore year of high school is a very important year both academically and socially. Not only will you be taking classes and learning at a more advanced level than you did your freshman year, but you will have the opportunity to take the PSAT 10. This is a valuable tool for estimating the range you may score on the SAT test, which can be a vital piece of your college planning.

Enjoy the rest of your summer. We look forward to seeing you at check-in on 7 August, and the first day of school on 15 August.

RHS Student Check-In 2017-2018

Welcome to the 2017-2018 school year! We hope your summer is going well. It is time to start thinking about the upcoming school year.

In General:

There is not a required school supply list at the high school level. Information needed for check-in will be located on the Rampart's website at www.asd20.org/rhs. You will find an optional purchase summary paragraph as part of the check-in information; use this information to determine fees that may apply to your student at check-in. Course fees will be posted to Infinite Campus once student schedule changes are completed. Please pay all applicable registration fees online through PayForIt.net, where you can pay with a credit card or by electronic check. If you choose not to use this convenient method of payment, your student can pay their applicable fees at check-in with cash, credit card, or **ONE** check made out to RHS. There are two (2) fee exceptions:

1) Write a separate check to **Creative Imaging** (see info sheet) if you choose to purchase a picture packet. For any questions concerning student school pictures, please go to the Creative Imaging web site at www.cidmphoto.com.

2) Write a separate check to **SODEXO** to place money in your students lunch meal account; SODEXO will have a separate table during check-in for your convenience.

Locker Information:

Please remember that a locker is not a requirement. Due to the limited number of lockers, please do not sign up for one unless you will use it. Students will have at least one locker partner and may choose their partner or one will be assigned. Students of the same grade level and gender share lockers, but may be assigned next to students in a different grade level as lockers are assigned randomly.

Returning RHS Students: If you are an incoming 10th, 11th, or 12th grade student who attended RHS the previous year and you already have a locker assigned to you, **you do not need to sign up for a locker**. If you never had a locker assigned to you and wish to use a locker, you can sign up for one on Rampart's website. You can choose a locker partner at that time. If you no longer need a locker, inform staff at check-in or on-line so it can be re-assigned.

New RHS Students: If you choose to use a locker, you can sign up for a locker on Rampart's website and you can choose a locker partner at that time. The same locker will be yours for your entire time at Rampart High School. If you request a locker partner, locker numbers and combinations will be emailed to you, otherwise you will receive that information at check-in.

Parent Portal Accounts:

All parents / guardians have a Parent Portal account on Infinite Campus if they provided District 20 with an email address when they registered their student. If you do not remember your password, please email District 20's help desk at help@asd20.org. ****PLEASE, parents, update your contact/account information!****

Otherwise, to obtain a parent portal account, e-mail the helpdesk (help@asd20.org) to request creation of a parent account. You will need to include your name, student's name, and your home address. You may also call the helpdesk at 234-1777, however email is better since the helpdesk gets very busy in August when school starts up. Once you have logged into your Parent Portal, there is a link to the **Extended Parent Portal**.

Handbook:

Rampart administration requires that parents and students read the Rampart High School Student Handbook. It contains valuable information for parents and students alike, and some policies have changed from previous years. Parents can use the extended parent portal to electronically sign and date the handbook.

Parents/guardians can complete their child's school registration, update student and family information - transportation, immunizations, emergency contacts, parent contact data, and electronically sign student agreements – through the Infinite Campus (IC) Extended Parent Portal. Parents can access the Extended Portal through the District 20 or RHS website. From either site click **Parents** at the top of the page, scroll down, and click **Extended Parent Portal**. Once logged in, the Portal will display the household name and the names of the members in that household, like so:

Alternating Block Schedule

Naviance Family Connection is a comprehensive website that you and your student can use to help in **making plans about courses, colleges, and careers**. Family connection is linked with Naviance Succeed, a service that we use in our office to track and analyze data about college and career plans, so it provides up-to-date information that is specific to our school.

Family connection will allow you and your student to:

- **Get involved in the planning and advising process**
 - Build a resume
 - Complete online surveys
 - Manage timelines and deadlines for making decisions about colleges and careers
- **Research college** – compare GPA, standardized test scores, and other statistics to actual historical data from our school for students who have applied and been admitted in the past.
- **Research Careers** – Research hundreds of careers and career clusters, and take career assessments like the Do What You Are test.
- **Create plans for the future** – Build course plans, create goals and to-do's, and complete tasks assigned to you by the school to better prepare yourself for your future college and career goals.
- **Request Transcripts** – All transcripts and recommendations must be requested and processed through Naviance.

Family Connection also lets us share information with you and your student about upcoming meetings and events, local scholarship opportunities, and other resources for college and career information.

To visit our school's Naviance Family connection site, use your browser to connect to the RHS website under the logins tab. The username is the student's ID number. The password is the student's first name initial, last name initial and 6 digit birthdate. Please note that this password will never change even if your student changes their Infinite Campus password.

Academy District 20 Graduation Requirements

For students graduating in the 2020-2021 school year, and for each graduating class thereafter, students must:

- I. Meet coursework requirements. These requirements, listed in the table below, have not changed for the class of 2021. These requirements, in effect since 2011, reflect a well-rounded sequence of courses that prepares D20 graduates for a wide range of post-secondary options.
- II. Demonstrate proficiency in both math and English language arts (ELA). This Colorado Department of Education requirement is new for the class of 2021. During each of the past three school years, Academy District 20 has convened a task force to develop procedures and options to meet the needs of all D20 students.

When meeting student health needs during the school day, health room school staff under the supervision and trained by district nurse use the opportunity to teach students to make wise choices, which are beneficial to their health.

High School Immunization Requirements for 2017-2018

As a parent, it is important to know that in addition to the vaccines required by the state of Colorado Board of Health for school entry. There are vaccines that are recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP). Parents will also find information on personal/medical exemption policy for immunizations at: The Colorado Department of Health: <https://www.colorado.gov/pacific/cdphe/schoolimmunizations>.

Schools work hard to ensure compliance with the immunization laws. Your help in providing updated immunization records at school registration and when your child receives additional vaccine(s) is greatly appreciated. Please discuss your child's vaccination needs with your child's doctor or local public health agency. (To find your local public health department's contact information call the Family Health Line at 1-303-692-2229 or 1-800-688-7777). Please bring your child's updated immunization records to the school by the first day of school in August of 2017.

Parents, please review the parent portal on Infinite Campus to see if you student's immunization record complies with the 2016-2017 immunization requirements. **Under Colorado law (C.R.S. §254-902), the penalty for failing to comply with the vaccination requirements or take an exemption will result in suspension.**

High School Medication

In high school, students who are mature and capable of taking their own over-the-counter or prescription medication (excluding controlled drugs) may self-carry their medication as instructed by their physician and / or parent provided the medication is carried in the original drug container. High school students who are taking controlled medications must keep their medication in the school office and follow Academy School District 20 & State Medication Administration guidelines. Parents / guardians must physically bring all controlled medications to be administered by school personnel to and from the school. Controlled medications are, but not limited to, stimulants, prescribed pain medications, antidepressants, anticonvulsants, and antipsychotics. In addition, a district medication consent form must be completed,

and signed by the parent / guardian and signed by the medical provider with prescriptive authority. The prescription medication must come in the original pharmacy container.

School Health Care Plans

To protect the health and safety of your student at school, it is the responsibility of the parent to notify the school nurse about acute and / or chronic health conditions. Please review the parent portal to see if listed health conditions are current and contact the school nurse if needed to update Infinite Campus health information. Health care forms related to Asthma/Diabetes/Severe Allergy/Seizures are available on the ASD20 website under "health services". It is imperative a health care plan (updated annually for current school year) is on file in the health office for students with asthma, life threatening allergies, seizures, diabetes, etc.

Locker Information

Rampart issues lockers with a padlock to students on check-in day, 7 August. If your student is unable to attend check-in day, we will issue lockers on 28 August during the check-in make-up day.

Lockers are the property of the school and loaned to students for their use. As a result, lockers are subject to inspection and maintenance by school administrators and other school personnel at any time.

Things to remember when obtaining a locker:

- **You do not have to be assigned a locker.** If you do not plan to use a locker please do not get one as the school has a limited number of lockers.
- You likely will have a locker partner due to the limited number of lockers.
- If you do not choose a locker partner one will be assigned to you at random.

Returning RHS Students: If your student is an incoming 10th, 11th, or 12th grade student who attended RHS the previous year, and already has an assigned locker, your student does not need to sign up for a locker. Your student has the same locker their entire time at Rampart. If your student has never had an assigned locker and would like to use a locker this coming year, your student can sign up for one on the Rampart website.

Rampart issues lockers at random so they are evenly distributed throughout the building. We make every attempt to assign students of the same grade level and gender to share lockers, but there are no locker sections by grade, so a student may have a locker next to a student in a different grade level.

The care and upkeep of the assigned locker becomes the locker partners' responsibility for the year; if students do not leave their locker clean, both locker partners will receive a \$5.00 clean up fee. Damage to lockers is also the responsibility of both locker partners, as are lost or missing padlocks; RHS replaces padlocks for a \$5.00 replacement fee.

All students participating in physical education classes and athletics should use PE /athletic lockers. Each student provides their own combination lock to go on their PE/athletic locker. **Rampart highly encourages students to leave valuables at home, but if they must be brought to school please keep them in a secure place. Students SHOULD NOT leave valuable items sitting in unsecured backpacks.**
